Insect/tick repellent

Survival

- Batteries (bring extras!)
Fire starter
Flashlight
Knife (pocket)
Matches / Match case
Mylar space blanket
Rope / Parachute cord
Signaling devices (mirror, whistle)
Bear bag / hanging ropes
Cook set
Eating utensils (Mess Kit)
Matches

Miscellaneous

- Camera/Film
Daypack
Fishing gear
Hiking stick
Pack repair kit
Large plastic bags (e.g., heavy mil garbage bags)
Safety pins
Sealable plastic bags (e.g., Ziploc or other)
Sewing kit
Sunscreen / lip balm

Uniform(s) (Class A)

Direction

- Compass
Highlighter

Feet

- Hiking Boots

Plastic liner bags (for use as vapor barrier at < 0°F)

Toiletries

- Biodegradable soap

Toothbrush / toothpaste
Towel / Washcloth
Dish Towel

Shelter

- Sleeping bag
Tarp (use as dining fly, etc.)
Tent (extra stakes!)
Waterproof ground cloth
